Youth Group

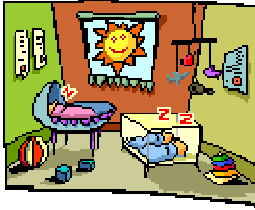
Our Youth Group will meet this Saturday, January 30th at 6:00 pm. Bring your friends for pizza, games, and discussion.

2nd Service Sermon Series – Making Love Last

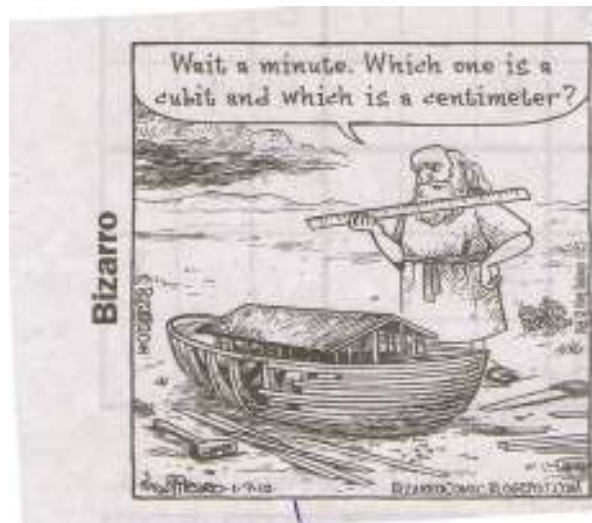
Today we are going to see *What Women wish Men Knew About Women!* This is one you won't want your man to miss! Next week we will look at what *Men wish Women Knew about Men!*
