

Study Questions

- 1) Why do you think God rejected Cain's offering? What was Cain's offering?
- 2) Why do you think Cain killed Abel?
- 3) Read Genesis 4:13-16. We didn't have time to cover this in the sermon today, so discuss these questions:
 - a. Genesis 4:14 says that whoever find him will kill him. Who could possibly find Cain? Adam and Eve? Who else was there? What are your thoughts about this?
 - b. What do you think the mark was that God placed on Cain?
- 4) Read Genesis 4:17. Pastor Maddox gave one point of view. Who do you think Cain's wife could have been? Do you think she was older or younger than Abel? Read Genesis 4:2 and 5:4 carefully when you consider your answer.
- 5) In Genesis Chapter 5 – the people lived a LONG time. Why do you think that was? Do you think they were years like we look at years? Do you think they were just some really old people? What was the reason?
- 6) Read Genesis 6:1-3. What does that mean our days are numbered to 120? Is this a good thing? Why do you think God doesn't want us to live like we are now forever?
- 7) Why did God flood the earth? Is this a loving God?
- 8) Does the rainbow sound like something that already existed and scripture was trying to explain it or do you think God did not invent rainbows until this time?
- 9) Read Genesis 9:18-21 – why do you think Noah got drunk?
- 10) Continue reading this story - What did Canaan do wrong?
